Sometimes when we know something really well we assume there is no need to study it any further.</p> <p>So even though we probably have expert knowledge of this one... try reading it again.</p> <p>What sticks out to you (sort of floats up in your mind) as you read it a second time?</p> <p>Did you notice something you've never seen before?</p> <p>Were the consequences too great? too little?</p> <p>What do you think of Eve at this point?</p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Day 4</i></p> <p>Read Galatians 4:1-7</p> <p>Do you remember a time when you were living "underage"? When sin ruled in your life?</p> <p>Consider the moment Jesus was born in that place of sin? What were your emotions?</p> <p>Jesus came to redeem every single part of us.</p> <p>Look up the word redeem in the dictionary.</p> <p>What part of the definition surprised you?</p> <p>Through Jesus we are no longer slaves, but daughters of the Most High. We get to call God "Abba" which means Daddy. Have you considered calling God Daddy? Why or why not?</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Day 2</i></p> <p>Read Genesis 3:21-24</p> <p>Make a list of God's actions in this passage.</p> <p>God sending man out of paradise seems harsh, but look closer.</p> <p>There were other trees in the garden. What tree do these verses mention?</p> <p>Adam and Eve were now broken, what would have happened if they ate from this tree?</p> <p>Banishing them from the garden was a terrible consequence but it was also a beautiful outpouring of grace.</p> <p>Have you noticed this before? How does it make you feel?</p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Day 5</i></p> <p>Read Romans 8:31-39</p> <p>Do you ever feel separated from God because of your sin? Write down the one thing you believe is causing separation.</p> <p>Read Romans 8:37-39 again</p> <p>That one thing you wrote causing separation. Write NOTHING over the word.</p> <p>Sister, you can never out sin God's ability to redeem. What's even more incredible is any separation... past, present, future... has already been paid for by His blood.</p> <p>Live free today in His redemption!</p> |
