Have you ever considered Jesus’ place before He came to earth?</p> <p>Jesus was there in the beginning as part of God. The “our” God is referring to points directly to God as a perfect community many call the Trinity.</p> <p>Jesus came and lived in the flesh, but we must never forget before He lived on earth... His blood covers every past sin... every present sin... every sin we will commit in the future.</p> <p>Is there some sin you still feel guilty about? Something keeping you wrapped in shame?</p> <p>Read Romans 8:1</p> <p>God’s capacity for grace is greater than your capacity for sin. Take some time to confess and Let.It.Go.</p> <p>Guilt and shame are not His work. He’s just not that way.</p>

Gives you reason to pause? Why?</p> <p>Read John 1:11-12</p> <p>What must we do to become a child of God?</p> <p>Jesus was fully God with all the power and glory in the heavenly realms and yet He chose to limit Himself for us.</p> <p>Consider some of the limitations of the flesh we live in each day? God experienced these same limitations through Christ. What does this tell you about our Savior?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Day 5</p> <p>Read John 3:16-17</p> <p>Have you heard this before? Many of us have verse 16 memorized, but what about 17?</p> <p>God did not send His son to _____ us. He sent His son to _____ us.</p> <p>Many of us have placed our belief in Jesus as God’s Son the one who died on the cross and through His resurrection saved the world.</p> <p>Maybe someone hasn’t.
